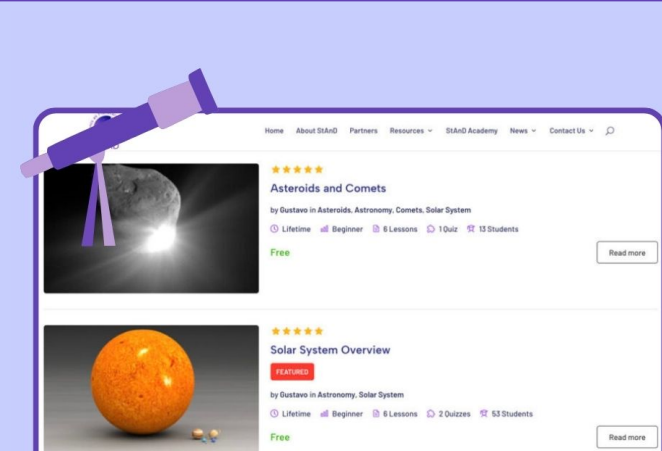

StAnD Community Days Highlight Meteor Science in Foligno
