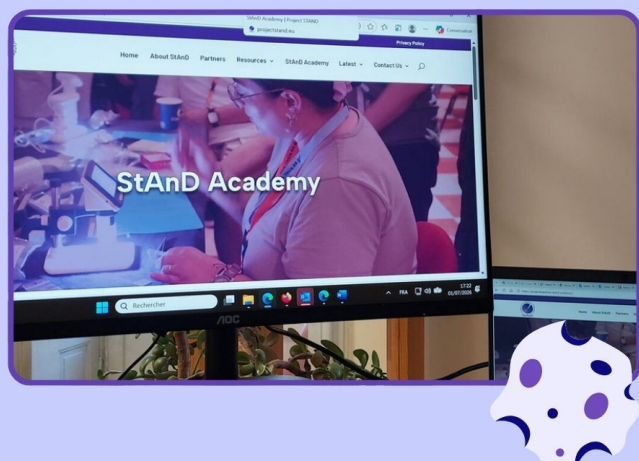
Students Captivated by Triangulation Labs in South of France
